- Movement for the stage (blocking, physical storytelling, basic choreography)
- Musical theatre performance (solo and ensemble singing, acting through song, performance technique)
- Audition skills and stage professionalism

Students will work on scenes, monologues, and musical selections in a supportive, structured environment that encourages growth at every level — from beginners to experienced performers. Emphasis is placed on teamwork, focus, and respectful collaboration. The workshop culminates in a live showcase performance for families and friends, giving students practical stage experience and a tangible goal to work toward.

This class is ideal for students who love storytelling, singing, and creative expression — and for those who simply want to build confidence speaking and performing in front of others. No prior experience required. Enthusiasm and willingness to participate are all that's needed.
